COVID-19 Swab **BEFORE** a Scheduled Surgery or Endoscopy

During the COVID-19 pandemic, all Groves Hospital surgical/endoscopy patients must have a negative COVID-19 swab to proceed with their scheduled appointment.

You are required to have a COVID-19 test **4-5 days prior to your surgical/endoscopy appointment**. Refusing to complete a COVID-19 swab will result in rebooking your appointment.

BOOKING A COVID-19 SWAB APPOINTMENT

- COVID-19 tests are by appointment only
- Please call either your Doctor's Office or the Fergus COVID-19 Assessment Centre to book an appointment at 226-383-2415 or you can book on-line at ww.whcacovid.com
- The Fergus COVID-19 Assessment Centre is located at 235 Union St. East, Fergus, ON N1M 1W3 and is open Monday thru Friday, 10 am to 6 pm

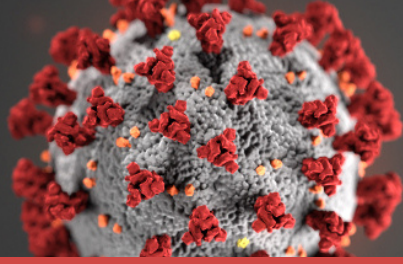
HOW TO GET YOUR COVID-19 TEST RESULTS?

- After you have your COVID-19 Assessment, please check on-line for your results at: www.publichealthontario.ca/en/laboratory-services/testresults
- You will need your OHIP number to view your results
- If you are having difficulty finding your results, please call your doctor's office
- Results are normally available two to three days after your swab
- You must have a negative COVID-19 test result to proceed with your surgical/endoscopy appointment

WHAT TO DO WITH THE TEST RESULTS?

- Once you receive your negative test result, please print the results and bring with you to your scheduled surgical/endoscopy appointment
- If your COVID-19 swab returns positive, your appointment will be postponed. **You must call your doctor's office to let them know and call the hospital Surgical Booking Clerk at 519-843-2010 ext. 40209.** You must also follow Public Health directive and self-quarantine.

Please note: if you are unwell prior to your scheduled surgery appointment contact your doctor or surgeon's office to notify them.

Information for Patients Undergoing a Surgery or Procedure

Socially Minimize Yourself Before Your Procedure/Surgery

Keep yourself away from others to minimize the risk of being exposed to COVID-19. If you must leave your house please wear a mask, wash your hands often and practice physical distancing from others. Monitor Your Symptoms - ask your self, daily, how do I feel?

Symptoms of COVID-19 are:

Fever	Decrease or loss of sense of taste or smell	Sore Throat
New or worsening cough	Pink eye (conjunctivitis)	Fatigue
Shortness of breath	Diarrhea	Vomiting
Runny nose or nasal congestion	Difficulty swallowing	Muscle aches

Immediately notify your surgeon if you, or anyone in your house, feel any of the above symptoms or are diagnosed with COVID-19. Please know that your surgery could be cancelled any time prior to your scheduled appointment if you are ill or experiencing symptoms.

Day of Procedure:

- Plan to have a support person to drop you off at the hospital Main entrance
- Here you will be greeted by a staff member who will screen you for COVID-19 and provide you with a mask that you must wear
- Bring minimal belongings and leave valuables at home
- Please have available the name and phone number of the caregiver picking you up after your surgery/procedure - this person must be readily available to pick you up after being called (within a half-hour)
- Please note you will be asked COVID-19 screening questions by your physician office before your appointment and the day you arrive for your appointment

Visitors:

In order to ensure the safety of our patients and staff, there are **no** visitors allowed. Special exceptions are made for children and those who require special support. This means any family members or companions will not be able to accompany you on the day of your procedure/surgery. This is an important precaution to ensure the safety of all of our patients and staff.

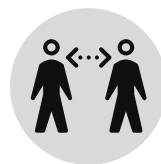
Hygiene Tips to Use During COVID-19:
