

## STAGE 2 SUBMITTED

- Groves' Stage 2 submission has been delivered to the Ministry of Health's Capital Branch and the Waterloo Wellington Local Health Integration Network (WWLHIN)
- The Stage 2 submission is comprised of documents which outline the functions, operations, staffing, major equipment, room and space requirements for each department or service in order to describe the components of a building. It also provides details of the facility's operating and capital funding requirements necessary to carry out the project
- The Hospital continues to work diligently with both the Ministry and the WWLHIN on gaining Stage 2 approval

## WELLINGTON COUNTY MUSEUM & ARCHIVES

- Wellington County Museum & Archives have kindly agreed to inventory and archive Groves' historical artifacts alongside items they currently possess. These items will then be secured during the new hospital construction and move
- These artifacts include historic documents, furniture, medical devices and photographs

## NEW HOSPITAL LANDS (WELLINGTON PLACE)

- Groves has been working with the County of Wellington and the Township of Centre Wellington to prepare a tender for road construction, providing access to the new hospital lands
- This construction will include water and sewer services to the site
- A Contractor will construct new hospital access roads along with the noted services. Construction is estimated to last until early winter 2014/15
- Once completed, a road will link Beatty line with Colborne Street and Wellington Road 18
- Following road completion, a Storm Water Management Pond will be constructed
